Day 01: Amboseli National Park

3 Nights (Full board) Permanent Tented Camp

Take a Scheduled flight from Wilson Airport to your camp in a wonderful conservancy on the edge of Amboseli National Reserve. Magnificent elephants, swamps and gnarled acacia trees – and if you're lucky, the snow-capped top of Kilimanjaro looming over it all.



Day 04: Meru National Park

3 Night (Full board) Seasonal Tented Camp

Hop on a flight to Meru National Park in northern Kenya. Off the beaten track but full of adventure, your home for 3 nights is a mobile camp in the old style. Remember Elsa the lioness? This is where she lived for a while. Night sounds come alive when you're living under canvas!



Day 07: Laikipia

3 Nights (Full board) Permanent Tented Camp

A short drive takes you to Laikipia Wilderness Camp, situated on a private concession. Enjoy exploring the area, which is home to many rare & unusual species: Grevy's Zebra, African Wild Dog, Reticulated Giraffe, Vulturine Guineafowl and many more. Cool down at the river, take a hike and enjoy stunning views of Mount Kenya to the south. This forms part of a massive, protected area through northern Kenya that is the only place outside the National Parks where animal numbers are increasing.



Day 10: Mara North Conservancy, Maasai Mara Reserve

3 Nights (Full board) Permanent Tented Camp

Another flight takes you south to Mara North Conservancy, your home for the next 3 nights. This is the ideal way to explore the Maasai Mara, combining the freedom of life on the conservancy with the ability to pop into the Reserve at any time. Game drives and walking options available.



Day 13: Heading Home

All good things come to an end, and today you bid goodbye to the Mara and head back to Nairobi and you flight back home.
